DETAILS

Cruise to Hamilton and explore the capital however you please by shopping on your own, enjoying a walking tour. After departing from the pier, you will soon settle in for a delightful cruise across the Great Sound, a body of impossibly turquoise water that fills the bend in the island's distinctive fishhook shape. A coral reef at the mouth of the sound shelters the inner waters, making for a typically calm cruise to the pastel-colored capital of Hamilton. Upon disembarking, you will have several options. If you choose to shop on your own, you can expect to find one-of-a-kind jewelry, vivid artwork celebrating the island life, and classic Bermuda shorts in every color of the rainbow. You might also pick up a tasty treat like rum cake or a jar of jam flavored with Scotch bonnet peppers. Another option is to split your time between exploring on your own and an enlightening walking tour of Hamilton. Either way, you may see the glorious Cathedral of the Most Holy Trinity, leafy Victoria Park and the Bermuda National Gallery, a showcase for centuries of outstanding island artwork.

NOTES

- This tour includes a moderate amount of walking mainly at the guest's discretion.
- Electric Wheelchairs and electric scooters cannot be accommodated on the tour boat.
- Collapsible wheelchairs can be transported but must be stowed during the boat cruise.
- All guests must be able to walk on and off the boat with limited assistance.
- Not all Hamilton shops are wheelchair accessible.
- Stores visited are at the guests discretion.
- Casual, weather-appropriate clothing, sunscreen and comfortable, flat walking shoes are suggested.
- Bar onboard is cash only.

DETAILS

Quintessential Bermuda exudes sophistication, subtropical climates and easygoing lifestyles. Though known as an island, Bermuda actually is a cluster of smaller inter-connecting islands surrounded by shallow reefs, turquoise water and pink sand beaches.

Tour Buses will pick up shipside where you embark on a scenic drive across the island's, through small villages, over drawbridges, into historic towns and lively cities. Sightsee along the South Shore offering views of strings of pink sand beaches with azure, blue waters.

Stop at the Gibb's Hill Lighthouse for opportunities to photograph 360-degree panoramic views of the island. Pass-by the manicured gardens and lush rolling hills of the Botanical Gardens, where your guide will point out the official residence of Bermuda's Premier, "Camden House".

Tour winding roads with orderly hedges into the cobble-stoned streets of the old town of St. George's. A tour stop here allows time to explore tiny alleyways and roads steeped in history or pick up a unique keepsake from the old Town souvenir shops.

Continue along the North Shoreline to the lively capital, City of Hamilton, a bustle of activity of International and local business, restaurants and bars. Browse and shop along famed Front Street, lined with boutique shops, souvenir storefronts, cafés and pubs.

When ready, choose the ferry that suits and enjoy a comfortable high-speed cruise via the million-dollar waterfront pastel homes, residential summer homes scattered along the islands of the Great Sound while en-route back to your ship.

DETAILS

The breathtaking South shores drive offers stops for photo opportunities to view famous Horseshoe Bay and other pink sand beaches, pretty pastel-colored houses with distinctive white roofs. A drive through quaint Somerset Village soon has you crossing over little Somerset Bridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world. Your tour then navigates the winding uphill drive to the base of Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, towering 120 feet above sea level, a great opportunity to photograph the 360-degree views of Bermuda.

You will stop to take in the sweeping view of John Smith's Beach, one of Bermuda's legendary pink hued beaches. Visit the historic Town of St. George's, the oldest continuously inhabited English town in the New World. The Town center provides a favorite photograph opportunity in the Stocks, aside the Ducking Stool and at the steps of St. Peter's Church, the oldest Anglican church of the Western Hemisphere. Rejoining your buses the route takes a coastline drive along the North Shore crossing over the Flatts Inlet, where the waters of Harrington Sound and the Atlantic Ocean merge to create swirling riptides that are visually spectacular. Arrive to famed Front Street, the busiest place on the island and life and soul of the lively capitol, City of Hamilton. Time allows for shopping and browsing in the boutique style shops and souvenir storefronts lining Hamilton Harbourfront.

This highly entertaining and informative tour truly earns its name as the ultimate water experience. Long recognized as one of Bermuda's best tours, you will probably learn more about the island in these two hours than others do during their entire vacation. The fun begins as soon as you step aboard your tour boat so be sure to bring along your sense of humor, which is a requirement for this intimate and friendly voyage, as well as your camera. At the helm is an award-winning Bermudian Captain, who will no doubt have you laughing from the moment you step aboard your comfortable tour boat. As you enjoy the natural beauty of the island and its diversity of plants and wildlife, your captain will be happy to share with you his knowledge of the birds and marine life you'll observe along the way.

Another highlight of this tour is the close-up views you'll have of some magnificent waterfront homes, such as those owned by Michael Douglas and Catherine Zeta-Jones, playwright Eugene O'Neal, and illustrator William Denslow, famous for his work on the "Wizard of Oz." You will also see Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, which is believed to be one of the oldest cast iron lighthouses in the world. The tour is often highly interactive and you are encouraged to participate in the lively discussions that arise about the people, politics and any other aspect of Bermudian life that is of interest to you. After a delightful cruise on Bermuda's exquisite turquoise blue waters, your tour boat will return you to the pier, filled with memories of the coastal wonders of this unique island paradise.
